

Create application which will take:

- Your **login** and script **URL** (pre-defined value is possible). Your **login** will be passed as the **login** argument to script **URL** which is: <https://homel.vsb.cz/~mor03/TAMZ/TAMZ.php>
- You will receive a secret **token** (as text/plain) in the reply to your request, which you will show in a new, read-only, input.
- Post a new request to the same **URL** without **login** argument, but with **API-Token header** set to base-64 encoded string s2 (hint: use $s2 = \text{btoa}(s1)$ to encode original string to base-64) The s1 string before base-64 encoding will be '**login:token**'.
